

ASLE AWARDS IN ECOCRITICISM AND ENVIRONMENTAL CREATIVE WRITING

The Association for the Study of Literature and Environment will present its fifth biennial book awards at its 2015 conference, to be held June 23-27, 2015 at the University of Idaho in Moscow, Idaho. Both awards include a prize of \$500. The awards will be presented at the authors' reception.

The Book Awards will be presented in two categories:

- the best book-length work of scholarly ecocriticism published in 2013 or 2014.
- the best book-length work of creative writing (any genre) on an environmental theme published in 2013 or 2014.

NOTE: *As instituted in 2013, we will now consider edited collections in both the scholarly and creative categories.*

- Works of narrative scholarship, or works that in other ways blend scholarly criticism with creative writing, can only be submitted in one category, which must be indicated in an accompanying letter.
- Works may be submitted by either the author or publisher. Authors are advised to coordinate with their publishers to avoid multiple, or missed, submissions.
- Nominees must be members of the Association for the Study of Literature and Environment or an international affiliate as of **January 1, 2015**.
- Works must be in English.
- Deadline for receipt of all submissions is **January 7, 2015**. Three copies of the nominated book should be sent to:
